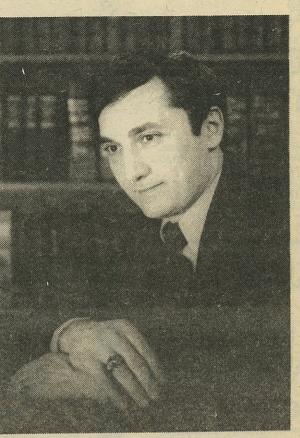
"Ideal" is a word frequently used to describe excellence or the lofty goals many of us would like to attain. Often, we use the word to refer to an individual who serves as a model for others.
